- *Physical*
- *Sensory*
- *Intellectual*
- *A combination of any of the above*

*The loss of function or disability
related to impairment which will
last six months or longer.*

- *Contract Board*
- *Residential Care*
- *Individualised Funding*
- *Working with and referring to other
Agencies e.g. Supported Employment
Agencies*
