

WHOOPING COUGH DANGER

Babies can catch whooping cough from YOU which could be fatal for a baby under 6 months.



On time immunisation is the best protection.

If someone in the house is coughing, any child under one year old is at risk of serious complications.

Immunisation is free for your child at:
6 weeks • 3 months • 5 months
4 years • 11 years
Boosters are required to maintain immunity.

(Immunity from having whooping cough or from previous vaccinations only lasts up to 10 years).
