Response: NMH does not have a specific policy regarding covert surveillance of staff.

2. The number of times there have been applications for surveillance of staff.

Response: NMH is not aware of any applications for surveillance of staff.

3. The number of times there have been approvals for surveillance of staff.

Response: Not Applicable.

4. The circumstances in which any surveillance of staff would be permissible.

<u>Response</u>: Any surveillance monitoring of employees during work would be a considered approach ensuring a policy, setting out why and when to monitor, complies with the Employment Relations Act 2000 and the Privacy Act 2020.
