Thank you for your request for official information received 10 August 2021 by Nelson Marlborough Health (NMH)¹, followed by clarification sought 13 August 2021 and the necessary extension of time 10 September 2021, where you seek the following oncology information.

1. The utilisation rate for, outpatient or day stay attendance for IV chemotherapy, expressed as a. patients per chair per day (plus definition of a chair day)
