Response to a request for official information

Thank you for your request for official information received 17 November 2021 by Nelson Marlborough Health (NMH)¹, where you seek the following information:

1. The total of 'Medical Certificate of Causes of Fetal and Neonatal Death' forms filled out, per month, since June 2020 to date in your District Health Board area. Please separate into Fetal Deaths and Neonatal Deaths per month. If permissible please advise the cause of death.

<u>NMH response</u>: Completed *Medical Certificate of Causes of Fetal and Neonatal Death* are not electronically captured in one place. This response would necessitate a significant amount of time and resource to manually search individual files, and would take staff away from their work and prejudice our ability to provide core clinical services. As such, NMH declines to respond under section 18(f) 'the information requested cannot be made available without substantial collation and research'. We do, however, record the number of births and deaths (Stillborns and Liveborns Deceased within 7 days of birth) at DHB facilities, as outlined below.
