Response to a request for official information

Thank you for your request for official information received 15 April 2019 by Nelson Marlborough Health (NMH)¹ where you seek the following information:

 How many assaults against nurses by members of the public, broken down by each year from 2013-2018.

Due to low numbers of physical assaults against nurses by members of the public, as outlined in Table 1, NMH declines to release exact numbers under Section 9(2)(a) 'to protect the privacy of natural persons, including that of deceased natural persons'. In the circumstances, the withholding of that information is not outweighed by other considerations which render it desirable, in the public interest, to make that information available. Our current Incident Management System was implemented in 2015.
