

Application process for HWD postgraduate funding

With your manager(s):

Have a discussion about your intent to apply for postgraduate funding

Consider your PDRP status

PDRP is a mandatory requirement for NMH employed nurses. You can talk with a PDRP resource person or Nurse Educator about the PDRP application process.

Gather documentation

1. A copy of your PDRP confirmation letter (NMH RNs)
2. A copy of your completed performance review if you are not currently in the PDRP programme (Primary RNs)
3. A copy of your academic record
4. Verified evidence of NZ residency or citizenship (if not born in New Zealand)
5. A copy of your plan for receiving clinical mentoring/supervision (if applicable)

Complete the electronic Career Plan AND HWD application 2nd September to 25th October 2019

You will receive an automatic email confirmation that your application has been received

Your Charge Nurse Manager/Manager:

Will receive a copy of your electronic career plan and prioritize applications in your area

PG Advisory group:

Will approve, waitlist and decline applications based on strategic priorities, the amount of funding available and applications prioritized by managers

You will be advised via email the outcome of your application on 29th November 2019

Decisions regarding HWD postgraduate funding

If funding for your application is confirmed:

- You will receive a confirmation letter indicating that your application has been endorsed
- You must complete the 'Acceptance of HWD Funding and Conditions for Postgraduate Nursing Study' form and needs to be signed by your manager(s). If your paper requires you to complete 60-160 hours of clinical supervision, you will need to discuss your plan for receiving this with the Nurse Consultant – Education and Development
- On completion of your paper you will be required to provide results and fill out a survey
- If any changes to your study status occur at any stage, you **MUST** inform the Nurse Consultant – Education and development. Contact PGNursing@nmdhb.govt.nz as soon as possible.

If funding for your application waitlisted:

- You will receive a letter confirming placement on a waiting list
- You will need to remain enrolled in case of any withdrawals from the funding pool

If funding for your application is declined:

- You will receive a letter confirming you're application has been declined
- You are encouraged to discuss your study options with the Nurse Consultant – Education and Development.
