## Response to a request for official information

Dear

Thank you for your request for official information received 10 October 2019 by Nelson Marlborough Health (NMH)<sup>1</sup> where you seek the following information:

Please only include those patients who undergo prostatectomy surgery who have a confirmed prostate cancer diagnosis, not those who require the surgery for other conditions.

NMH responds in reference to the Faster Cancer Treatment file, based on a patient's referral date from January to August 2019 and with confirmed malignant neoplasm of prostate.

1. The current waiting time for an appointment following a referral from a GP for a prostate cancer initial consultation

14 days.

2. The current waiting time for a follow-up appointment for a prostate biopsy

This waiting time is defined as the time between a First Specialist Appointment (FSA) and an appointment for a Trans rectal ultrasound guided (TRUS) biopsy:

7 days.

3. The current waiting time for a post-biopsy appointment to discuss results and treatment options

This waiting time is defined as the time between a TRUS biopsy – either as a FSA or a Follow Up Appointment – and a further outpatient appointment for TRUS biopsy.

19 days.

4. The current waiting time for a radical prostatectomy following the post-biopsy appointment for persons with a confirmed prostate cancer diagnosis.
