Response to a request for official information

Thank you for your request for official information received 8 July 2020 by Nelson Marlborough Health (NMH)¹, where you seek the following information:

- 1. The number of people that require a kidney transplant?
- 2. The number of people that have required a kidney transplant for the last five years?
- 3. Could I also have that broken down into gender and age?
- 4. The number of people who have actually had kidney transplants for the same periods?
- 5. The number of people that require a kidney transplant but need to lose weight first?
- 6. The number of people who have had a kidney transplant after losing weight?
- 7. How many people have died waiting for a kidney transplant?

<u>NMH response</u>: We have an agreement with the Wellington Renal Transplant Service for kidney transplantation as part of tertiary level service provision for Nelson Marlborough patients. As the information you seek is not captured by NMH, we suggest you contact Capital & Coast District Health Board.
