## Response to a request for official information

Thank you for your request for official information received 7 July 2020 by Nelson Marlborough Health (NMH)<sup>1</sup>, where you seek the following information:

- 1. The number of clients who received immediate breast reconstruction following a mastectomy in 2019/20
- 2. The average breast reconstruction wait time for 2019/20
- 3. The number of women currently on the waitlist for reconstruction following a mastectomy
- 4. The number of women who did not meet waitlist criteria
- 5. An outline of criteria that guides/ governs whether a woman seeking breast reconstruction is accepted or denied treatment.

<u>NMH response</u>: We have an agreement with Hutt Valley District Health Board to carry out breast reconstruction surgery as part of tertiary level service provision for Nelson Marlborough patients. As the information you seek is not captured by NMH, we suggest you contact Hutt Hospital Plastics Department.
