 The overall percentage of staff vaccinated and not vaccinated, and break the data down into different departments, the most to the least.

<u>NMH response</u>: Table One below shows the percentage of the entire NMH workforce who have received the COVID-19 vaccine, noting the workforce count includes staff in Group 4 who are yet to be invited to receive the vaccine, and a breakdown by department is not currently available.
