Response to a request for official information

Thank you for your request for official information received 1 March 2022 by Nelson Marlborough Health (NMH)¹, followed by the necessary extension of time 23 March 2022.

I'm reporting on staff shortages due to omicron, either sickness or household contacts.

 How many staff members are in that position in your DHB, please. It would also be good to know what percentage of total staff are either sick or in isolation, please.

NMH response:

As at 14 March 2022, the total workforce percentage for sick leave, including pandemic leave, across Nelson Hospital and Wairau Hospital was 5.2 percent. This was slightly down from 5.5 percent the previous week.

The number of staff absent due to Covid-19 fluctuates regularly and can be challenging to record accurately, given any definitional issues and reliance on information entered into the on-line reporting system by each submitter.
