## Response to a request for official information

Thank you for your request for official information as transferred from the Ministry of Health and received 12 January 2022 by Nelson Marlborough Health (NMH)<sup>1</sup>, where you seek the following information:

 Please tell me if publically funded bone density (DEXA) scans are available for (1) all relevant Endocrinology patients (2) any patient seen in a relevant subspecialty (yes/no adequate detail for both questions). The scan could be provided in private but the question is about who pays

 the DHB or the patient. If some patients would be funded (e.g. community service card holders) please provide this information.

## NMH response:

We outsource DEXA (dual energy X-ray absorptiometry) scans to private providers and this imaging service is publicly funded by NMH.
