NMH response:

There were 60 referrals for women to Maternal Mental Health for NMH in 2021. All referrals were accepted.

NMH response:

The current average waiting time for Maternal Mental Health cannot be provided because this information is not currently collected in any of our systems. As such, we decline to respond under section 18(g) of the Act in 'that the information requested is not held' by NMH.
