

Thank you for your request for official information received 23 May 2022 by Nelson Marlborough Health (NMH)¹, where you seek following information.

1. "Does the DHB have a "dedicated AOD clinician"in the Nelson/Blenheim district courts?"

NMH response:

Yes, we have dedicated alcohol and other drug (AOD) clinicians in the courts.

2. "Is the clinician's role primarily focused on providing brief assessments (as in alcohol and drug screening which might take 15-20 minutes) or providing comprehensive AOD assessments (which would include background issues and circumstances - including mental health issues - which might predispose the offender to using alcohol and drugs?"

NMH response:

Yes, they conduct comprehensive assessments only.

3. "Does that dedicated clinician have any responsibilities other than providing alcohol and drug assessments to the courts? If so, what are those other responsibilities?"

NMH response:

Yes, they are 'community alcohol and other drug' health clinicians. Other roles are dependent on the professional scope of practice of the health practitioners.

 "Can you please advise, how many comprehensive alcohol and drug assessments were provided to the courts in Nelson/Blenheim in 2021?"

NMH response:

210.
