Response to a request for official information

Thank you for your request for official information received 19 May 2022 by Nelson Marlborough District Health Board, followed by the necessary extension of time 17 June 2022, where you seek the following information.

1. *“A count and list of all buildings owned, occupied, rented, leased or in use.”*
2. *“The count and list of buildings from question 1 that have had a seismic assessment since 1 July 2017.”*
3. *“The count and list of buildings from question 1 that have not had a seismic assessment since 1 July 2017.”*

Health NZ Te Whatu Ora – Nelson Marlborough Response:

The above information is not held in a form that is readily retrievable from our Information System, and we do not currently have the capacity to extract, manually review and compile the information— under section 18(f) *‘the information requested cannot be made available without substantial collation and research’*.

4. *“The count and list of those from question 1 that are currently earthquake prone.”*

Health NZ Te Whatu Ora – Nelson Marlborough Response:

There is currently 1 earthquake prone building:

- Nelson boiler house; the Nelson boiler house chimney has also been separately identified as earthquake prone.
5. *“The count and list of those from question 4 that are between 20 percent and less than 34 percent of the New Building Standard (NBS).”*

Health NZ Te Whatu Ora – Nelson Marlborough Response:

The Nelson boiler house is within 20-34% of the NBS.

6. *“The count and list of those from question 4 that are less than 20 percent of the New Building Standard (NBS).”*
