Te Whatu Ora Nelson Marlborough Response:

This information is not clinically coded and held in a form that is readily retrievable from our Information System. It would take a significant amount of time and resources to extract and manually review individual patient files to determine if any intra-uterine contraceptive device (IUCD) removal involved an Essure device and under section 18(f), 'the information requested cannot be made available without substantial collation and research'.
