## Response to a request for official information

Dear

Thank you for your request for official information received 25 May 2022 by Nelson Marlborough Health (NMH)<sup>1</sup>, where you seek the following information.

#### Caveats:

#### \*Timeframe

Data is supplied by Financial Year (1 July – 30 June) 2018/2019 to 2021/2022ytd Following information system changes in May 2018, data processes between the old and new systems are not easily comparable.

## \*Methodology

Wait times are calculated from the date of the General Practice (GP) Referral to the date the patient is actually seen at the First Specialist Appointment (FSA).

The FSA may not be the first contact a patient has after a referral. Before a patient receives a FSA, services may instigate diagnostics/investigations and surveillance, and in some cases this can be over long periods of time, therefore days waiting may appear to be high for some services.

## \*Wait times

Wait times do not take into account the different Prioritisation categories placed against a Referral when wait listing a patient for Surgery.

Wait times in the Emergency Department (ED) do not take into account the different Triage categories.
