Thank you for your request for official information received 8 November 2021 by Nelson Marlborough Health (NMH)¹, followed by the necessary extension of time 6 December 2021, where you seek the following information:

1. Who is given information on the daily Covid cases in each DHB region in advance of any Ministry of Health or government statement, or briefing?

Response:

NMH endeavours to provide a brief update to the Marlborough and Nelson/Tasman Regional Leadership Groups regarding any positive cases in the District. Generally this occurs after immediate case investigation has commenced and prior to Ministry of Health public release.

2. Which stakeholders and/or partner organisations are given information?

NMH response:

The Regional Leadership Groups consist of local Iwi, Mayors, Council, Ministry of Social Development, Police, National Emergency Management Agency, and Chamber of Commerce.

3. The nature of the information; what information about the Covid cases are people given?

<u>NMH response</u>: General information that does not contravene patient privacy is passed on generally being limited to the number of cases, Territorial Local Authority where they are being isolated and any follow up action occurring.
